

e-Filing in Massachusetts

The Supreme Judicial Court (SJC), the Appeals Court and many trial courts now permit electronic filing through the e-filing service provider, Tyler Technologies ("Tyler"), on the Massachusetts Court System Odyssey File and Serve. The Committee for Public Counsel Services (CPCS) has an agency account and staff attorneys may request a subaccount under the CPCS account.

To register for a CPCS subaccount: Note that staff cannot register for a subaccount from the Odyssey File and Serve home page. In order to register for a CPCS subaccount you must request an invitation email from our **Agency Administrator Stephanie Cafarella**. After you receive the invitation email, click the link in the body of the email and you will be guided through the registration process. Once you click on "Create My Account", Stephanie will then need to approve your subaccount before you can begin using the e-Filing system.
